- Established in 1982 with the approval of the State Council
- A comprehensive research institute directly under MOST
- **President** : Mr. Wan Gang, Minister of the MOST and Vice-Chairman of National Committee of the CPPCC; Executive Vice President: Wang Yuan
- **Research Strength**: national S & T development strategies, policies, mechanism, management, foresight, assessment, and playing the role of S & T in facilitating social and economic development

- Founded in 1993 , one of the leading think tanks in China
- Carry out research to facilitate decision making of Chinese government, Hi-tech parks and enterprises

- ◆ The Center invites 1-2 STI research institute of each ASEAN country to join a China-ASEAN STI Policy Research Network (the Network)

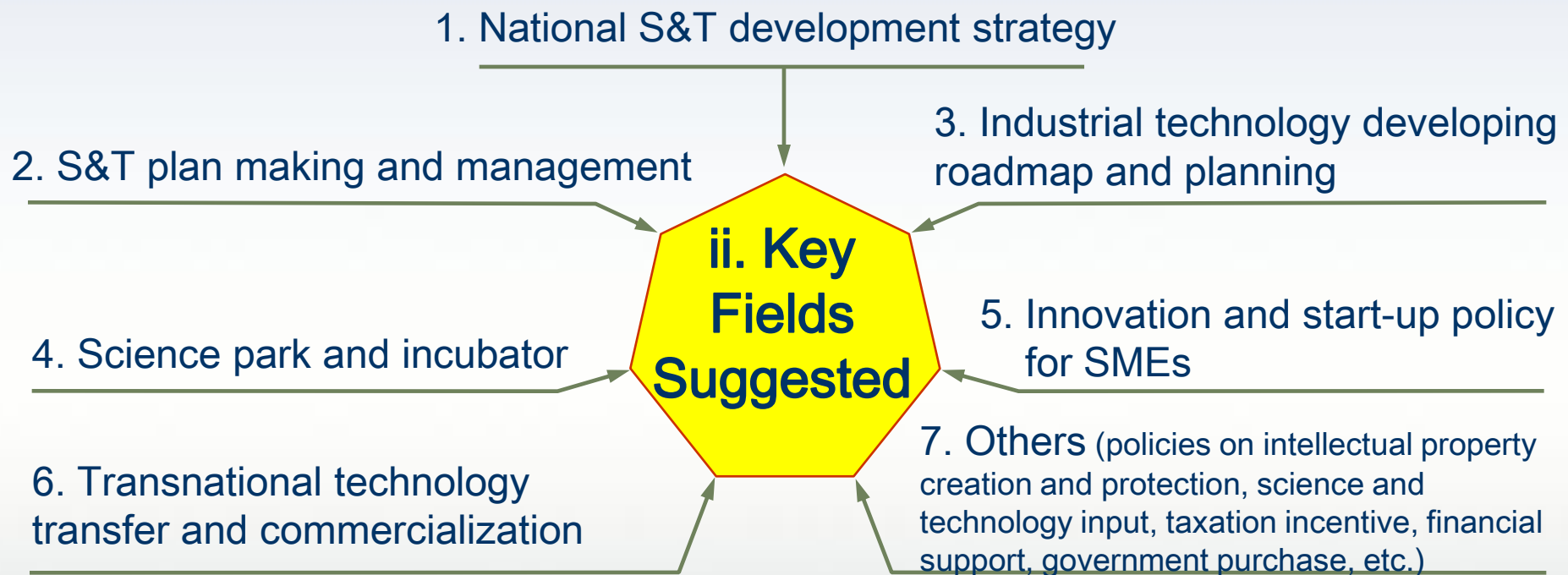


### i. Objective

### iii. Main Modes of Cooperation

#### 1. Research seminar

- Select important topics annually and organize China-ASEAN STI Policy seminars to share experiences and facilitate cooperation

#### 2. Joint research

- Carry out joint research of STI policy on bilateral and multilateral levels, meeting member's demands.

#### 3. Training workshop

- Organize workshops on specific topics, and introduce each country's successful experience regarding STI policies

#### 4. Visiting scholars

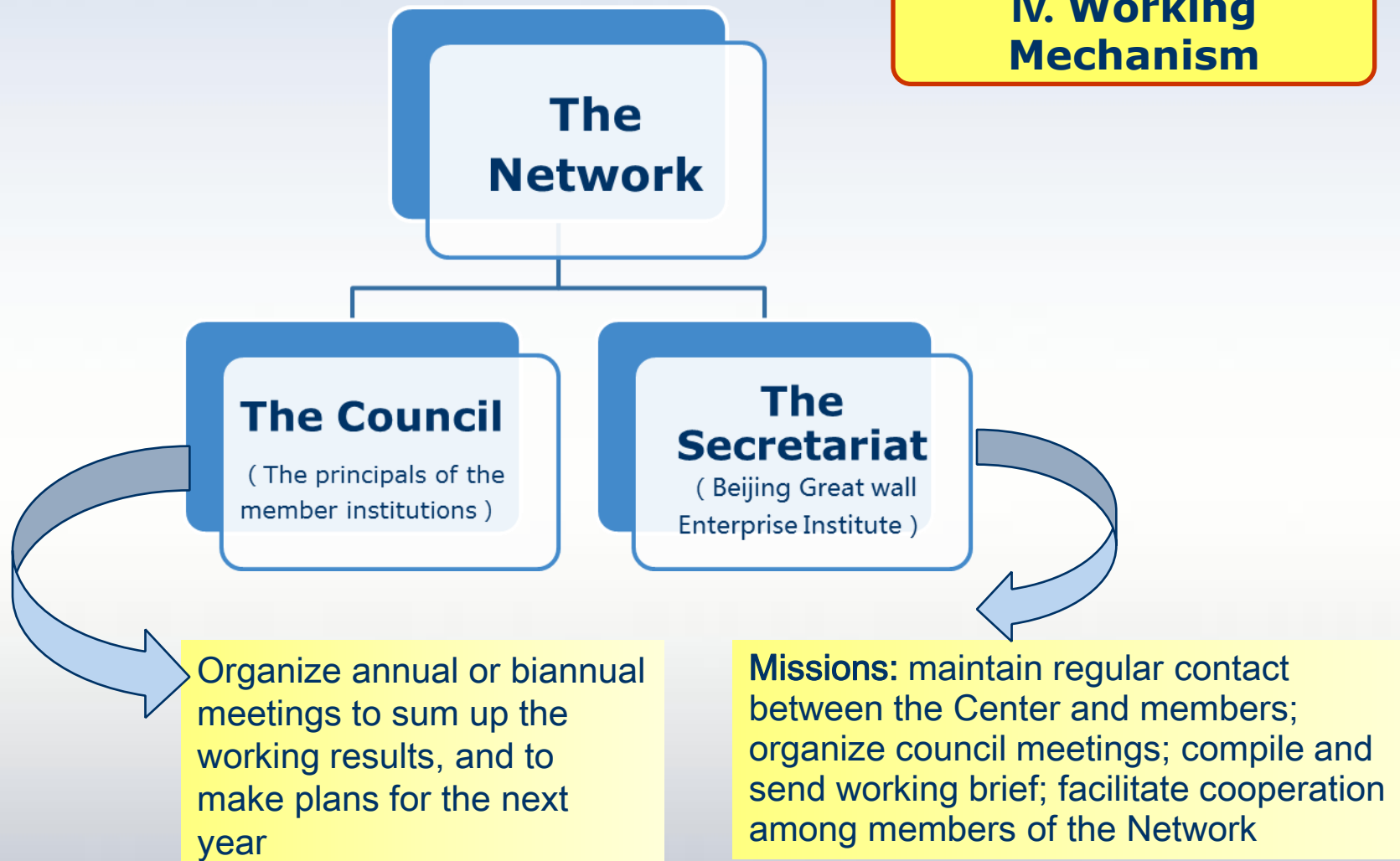
- sponsor science and technology research personnel to visit and study in a member country

### v. Funding Resources

Members who apply and host relevant activity will bear its expenses.

Chinese MOST will provide financial support to the following operation and activities of the Network :

1. Provide funding to the **Secretariat** for its **daily operation**;
2. Sponsor one **China-ASEAN STI Policy Training Workshop** (it can be hosted in China or organized jointly with ASEAN countries)
3. Sponsor China-ASEAN STI Policy Research Center and other members to do **joint research**, according to the requirements of ASEAN countries
4. Sponsor **5-10 STI policy researchers** from ASEAN countries annually to Chinese STI policy research institutes for **6-12 month visit and exchange**.
